Sheriff's Office Needs Reserve Deputies

The Shelby County Sheriff's Office is taking applications for a Reserve Deputy class that begins **August 3, 2009**.

"We currently have about 150 Reserve Deputies serving with the Sheriff's Office. Our goal is to eventually have 200 Reserve Deputies working in several bureaus," said Shelby County Sheriff Mark H. Luttrell, Jr.

Reserve Deputies receive six months of training which includes physical agility, the use of firearms and Sheriff's Office policies and procedures.

Classes will be held at the Sheriff's Office Training Academy at 993 Dovecrest on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings from 6:00 until 10:00. Saturday sessions will be held from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.

Qualifications:

- U.S. Citizen
- Be 21 years-old
- Pass a criminal background check
- Serve a minimum of 24 hours each month
