ENDANGERED MISSING PERSON

Sheriff's Deputies are searching for an elderly man who failed to return home this evening.

Family members say Leo Shaffer, 84, of North Mary Creek Cove in Arlington, suffers from Alzheimer's disease and left home earlier today to get his oil changed at a Chevrolet dealership in Bartlett.

Shaffer went to the dealership on Highway 64 at Kate Bond Road about 10 a.m. Relatives called Deputies this evening when he failed to return home.

Family members say this is not the first time Shaffer has become confused while driving. Shaffer's vehicle is a white 2005 GMC Sierra extended cab pick up truck with Tennessee tag 639-FNX.

Shaffer was wearing a green North Face jacket and khaki pants. He has grey hair, brown eyes and wears glasses. He stands 5 feet 5 inches tall and weighs 125 pounds.
