Suspect Takes Customer's Money From Money Machine

Sheriff's detectives continue their search for a woman who took another person's money from a credit union several months ago.

On the afternoon of October 22, 2009, a woman went inside the Memphis Area Teachers' Credit Union at 7960 Lowrance Road to get some cash.

She sent her personal information through a money kiosk machine controlled by a teller.

During the transaction, the customer briefly stepped away to get something from her car. When the woman returned to the machine, her cash and driver's license were gone.

Video from a security camera showed another woman walk-up to the money machine and take the customer's cash and driver's license.

The suspect is a heavy-set black woman, approximately 50-years-old and wore dark clothes.
